

2003 Top GA Airports in the U.S.

In a continuing effort to feature the importance of general aviation airports in supporting the needs of private air transportation in the United States, Aviation Resource Group International and Airport Journals present America's Top 100 General Aviation Airports.

A renewed relevance for America's business aviation airports is occurring as a direct result of the inability of the commercial airlines to provide the essential transportation required to meet the transportation needs of American business.

The financial problems of America's airlines, combined with the success of fractional aircraft ownership, have created a new era for general aviation. Notwithstanding the recent increase in what was once a sluggish economy, many of America's airports are continuing to grow.

Airport growth can be determined by any number of quantitative and qualitative measures. We will be examining the Top 100 GA Airports based upon the number of FAA reported itinerant operations.

The Top 100 GA Airports as ranked by operations represent an interesting mix throughout the continental U.S. In many cases, the top airports represent high-volume, business-aircraft activity (Van Nuys, VNY; Daytona, DAB; Orlando, SFB; Ft. Lauderdale Executive, FXE; and Phoenix, DVT); in contrast, many other airports achieved their presence elsewhere in the Top 100 (Teterboro, TEB; Orange County, SNA; and Dekalb-Peachtree Atlanta, PDK).

The top two contenders managed to hold the same position as 2002. The top two airports haven't changed over the last four years, with Van Nuys (VNY) and Daytona Beach (DAB) holding the first and second positions, respectively.

Elsewhere in the array of the TOP 100 GA Airports is perceptible movement. As an example, Phoenix (DVT) advanced from number 11 in 2000 to number 4 in 2002, and number 5 in 2003. There is also a measurable level of stability within the Top 10 positions with airports such as Denver Centennial (APA) ranking 4, 4, 6 and 10, from 2000 to 2003, respectively; Fort Lauderdale Executive (FXE) 3, 5, 3 and 4, from 2000 to 2003; and Long Beach (LGB) 7, 7, 7 and 8, from 2000 to 2003.

It has been said that "knowledge is power." To the extent that Airport Journals and ARG International can provide more "knowledge" about the top airports serving general aviation, the business and recreational aviation community will become aware of those airports central to the success of the private/corporate aviation marketplace.

National D-Day Museum to Commemorate 60th Anniversary

The National D-Day Museum will commemorate the 60th Anniversary of the Allied Invasion of Normandy, one of the most pivotal events of the 20th Century, on June 5 and 6.

The weekend events will range from invasion briefings and weather situations to rock climbing and Home Front activities for children. A special Sunrise Service Sunday morning will include a pause in remembrance of those who didn't make it back home to enjoy the victory they helped win.

Located in New Orleans, La., the museum opened its doors on the 56th anniversary of the Normandy invasion. Its fourth anniversary will be marked with a presentation of the museum's dramatic expansion plans.

June 5 activities will include living history encampments; hourly tactical briefings, in a simulated World War II briefing room; vintage military vehicles and firepower demonstrations.

That evening, the museum will host "An Evening of Wine and War," from 7 p.m. to midnight, a special night in the Louisiana Memorial Pavilion observing the "Decision to Go" that launched the invasion. In a recreation of a forties-era Parisian nightclub, guests will sample cuisine from some of New Orleans' top local restaurants paired with complimentary French wines, as Tony Green and Gypsy Jazz entertain the crowd, along with an Edith Piaf inspired vocalist, and dance the night away to the sounds of the 1940s. Advance tickets are \$75 for museum members and \$100 for the public. Tickets are available on the day of the event for \$125. On Sunday morning, June 6, commemorative events will begin at sunrise—just as our troops were landing on the Normandy beaches 60 years ago. That day, a new exhibition, "Normandy, D-Day Plus 60," will premiere. Included in the schedule is a live telecast and ceremony from Andrew Higgins Drive, from 10:00 am to 10:45, with American Battlefield Monuments Commission officials at the American Cemetery at Omaha Beach, France.
